Let's catch up, meet new faces, and reintroduce the interest groups. We will have a small catered lunch and delicious sweet treats!

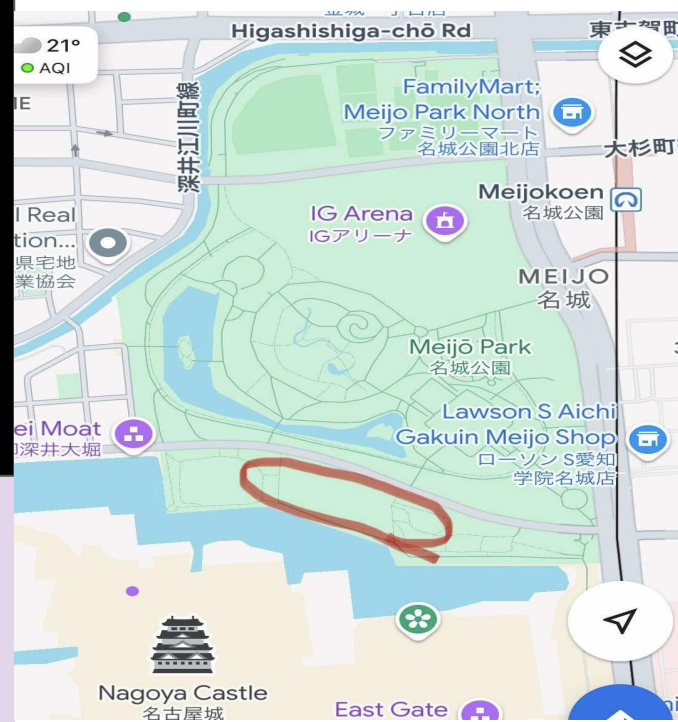
