Just to mention a few, his Rakugo was nominated for Best Unique Theatrical Experience for the 2020 Off-Broadway Alliance Awards. He was the bilingual MC for the opening reception of the G20 Summit in Osaka in 2019. He has also won personal praise from former Prime Minister Shinzo Abe for his efforts in promoting Rakugo to foreigners.
